- You will need to provide information about memberships, horse microchips, and contact details. You can autofill most information using your USEF numbers:

 - If you are on a Beverly horse, Beverly Equestrian's USEF is 5207254
- Add a credit card to your account for convenience when submitting entries.

- International Polo Club (IPC): Watch high-goal polo matches on Sundays. Tailgate spots and VIP brunch options are available.
